## Ornament

We have prepared a tutorial for you to make earrings with beads and seed beads from the PRECIOSA Traditional Czech Beads ${ }^{T M}$ brand. You can try out combining the PRECIOSA Chilli ${ }^{T M}$ and PRECIOSA Thorn ${ }^{T M}$ Pressed Beads supplemented with PRECIOSA Rocailles in these sewn earrings. We wish you pleasant beadworking.

Step 2:
Return through the top hole of the $\mathbf{C H}$ (fig. no. $2 \mathrm{a}+2 \mathrm{~b}$ ) and then join the top hole of the CH (fig. no. 2c) again.

## Difficulty: 1010

Technique: beadweaving

## Procedure:

Step 1:
String $3 \times \mathbf{R}, 1 \times \mathbf{C H}$-lower hole, $1 \times \mathbf{R}, 1 \times \mathbf{C H}-$
lower hole, 1 x T, $1 \mathrm{x} \mathbf{C H}$-lower hole, $1 \mathrm{x} \mathbf{R}, 1 \mathrm{xCH}$
-lower hole and $3 \times \mathbf{R}$ (fig. no. 1a +1 b).

a 0.20 mm line-a length of ca $2 \times 70 \mathrm{~cm}$; a sewing needle; scissors;pliers;


2 x earring hooks; 2 x 8 mm rings



Step 3:
String the $\mathbf{R}$ and thread the needle through the following $\mathbf{C H}$ in the top hole (fig. no. 3 a +3 b) and connect it again with the adjacent $\mathbf{C H}$ using the top hole (fig. no. $3 \mathrm{c}+3 \mathrm{~d}$ ).

Step 4:
Thread the needle through the $3 \mathbf{R}$ (fig. no. $4 a+4 b$ ). Now, it is necessary to strengthen the base. Do this by threading the line around the bottom and top rows several times (fig. no. $4 \mathrm{c}+4 \mathrm{~d}+4 \mathrm{e}$ ).

## Step 5:

Thread the needle through the middle $\mathbf{R}$ (fig. no. 5a), string 11x R (fig. no. 5b) and thread the needle through the middle $\mathbf{R}$ on the other side (fig. no. $5 \mathrm{c}+5 \mathrm{~d}$ ).

Step 6:
Now thread the needle back through the bottom row (fig. no. 6a); it is necessary to emerge from the middle $\mathbf{R}$ again
(fig. no. 6b).


## 6 b .



Thread the needle through 5 R (fig. no. 7a), leave out one $\mathbf{R}$ and thread the needle through 6 R , so that you finish in the middle $\mathbf{R}$ from the base (fig. no. $7 b+7 c$ ).


Step 8:
It is necessary to tighten the entire component at the end, so sew through the base in a circle several times (fig. no. $8 \mathrm{a}+8 \mathrm{~b}$ )

Step 9:
Sew in the ends of the lines in the usual manner and the base is finished (fig. no. 9). Repeat Steps 1-9 so that you have two of them.

Step 10:
Use the pliers to attach the rings and earring hooks and the earrings are finished (fig. no. 10a + 10b).
