## Bracelet with little bells

Preciosa Ornela has created an identical two-hole version of the PRECIOSA Twin Pressed Bead, offered in all the existing glass colors, in order to expand the color range of the popular PRECIOSA Twin two-hole seed beads. Create a sturdy bracelet with little bells sewn around with beads and seed beads from the PRECIOSA Traditional Czech Beads ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ brand in red, white and blue.

Can you tell which of these colors is a PRECIOSA Twin seed bead and which a PRECIOSA Twin?

## Materials and tools:

- metal parts - small silver bells (9x); 6 mm silver rings; silver eye pins; a strong chain; an adjusting chain; a 14 mm snap hook

- a o.20 mm line; flat nose, snipping and needle nose pliers; a thin stringing needle

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## Difficulty:

Technique: stringing

## Procedure:

Some of the total number of small bells which are hung on the chain using the rings (9x) will sewn around with Twin beads (for example, 6 bells). You can create your own color combinations and ornamentation by means of the use and layout
of the chosen colors.
Step 1
String $8 \mathrm{x} \mathbf{T}$ and tie them into a basic circle. Pull the end of the line back into the hole of the nearest $\mathbf{T}$. Continue according to the drawing (figure no. 1), pass the line through both holes of the nearest $\mathbf{T}$ and string $8 \mathrm{x} \mathbf{T}$ in the second row between the individual $\mathbf{T}$ of the first row of the basic circle. Add $2 \times \mathbf{T}$ between the individual $\mathbf{T}$ in the third row. Always continue in the following row by passing the line through both holes of the first T of the given row. In the following rows, only add one seed bead in the gaps between the individual $\mathbf{T}$.

Sew around the bells using 10-11 rows of $\mathbf{T}$. The list of the Twin in
the individual rows
Row 1: 8x T;
Row 2: 8x T;
Row 3: 16x T;
Rows 4-7 or rows 4-8: 16x T;
Row 8 (9): 16x T;
Row 9 (10): 8x T;
Row 10 (11): 8x T, 4x R


Step 2
Place the bell inside at the midway point of creating the rows and then reduce the numbers of $\mathbf{T}$ in the following individual rows. Only add the individual $\mathbf{T}$ to every second gap. String 8x T and 4x R (figure no. 2) in the final row. Pass the line through both holes of the first $\mathbf{T}$ and then pass the line through all of the second holes of the $\mathbf{T}$ in the last row, pull the Twin into a circle and finish with a strong knot. Pull the end of the line into the nearest holes and cut.


## Step 3

Attach the sewn-round bells to the chunky bracelet chain in the order of $2 x$ sewnround bells and $1 x$ undecorated bell using a total of ninebells $(6+3)$. Connect a snap hook to the end of the chain using the rings and the adjusting chain ended with a seed bead to the other end.
