## PRECIOSA Tubes

32111 001; $40 \times 3 \mathrm{~mm} ; 50 \times 3 \mathrm{~mm} ; 60 \times 3 \mathrm{~mm}$


Preciosa Ornela introduces beads and seed beads from the PRECIOSA Traditional Czech Beads ${ }^{T M}$ brand.


## Night Sky

Ifyou enjoy using the eye-pin linking technique, this project has something for you. It uses the bigger and stronger PRECIOSA Tubes with a larger hole. These seed beads come in three sizes: $40 \times 3 \mathrm{~mm}$, $50 \times 3 \mathrm{~mm}$ and $60 \times 3 \mathrm{~mm}$.

## Materials and tools:

PRECIOSA Tubes
32111 001; $40 \times 3 \mathrm{~mm}$;
2398P black-green;
the necklace: 10x; the earrings: $4 \mathrm{x}\left(\mathrm{T}_{4}\right)$
32111 001; $50 \times 3 \mathrm{~mm}$; 2398P black-green; the necklace: 12x ( $\mathrm{T}_{5}$ )

32111 001; $60 \times 3 \mathrm{~mm}$;
2398P black-green;
the necklace: 12x (T6)
PRECIOSA Pressed Beads (PB)
11130310 ; $10 \times 9$;
ooo30/27401 crystal-grey;
the necklace: 17 x ; the earrings 2 x
$-70 \mathrm{~mm}, 60 \mathrm{~mm}$ and 50 mm eye pins; a 20 mm eye pin; 8 mm rings (20x);
5 mm rings (20x); a chain (about 14 links in every 5 cm ); a carabiner; the counterpart to the carabiner


- needle-nosed pliers; flat-nosed pliers; snipping pliers



## Procedure:

## The necklace

Step 1:
Put a $\mathbf{T}_{4}$ on an eye pin. You will need about 8 to 10 mm of wire to twist it around the end of the point, depending on the length of the pin. You can snip off any excess wire as needed. Grasp the edge of the protruding wire between the points of the needle-nosed pliers. Twist it around the points. This will create an eye. Gently bend the eye back around the edge of the $\mathrm{T}_{4}$ so that it is centrally positioned above the hole of the $\mathbf{T}_{4}$.


## Step 2:

Do the same with all $\mathrm{T}_{4}$


## Step 3:

Do the same with all $\mathrm{T}_{5}$.


Step 4:
Do the same with all $\mathbf{T} 6$.

Step 5:
Put all the PB on an eye pin. The eyes should be twisted at $90^{\circ}$ in relation to one another (one eye flat, i.e. in line with the $\mathbf{P B}$, and the other vertical


Step 6:
Connect the $\mathbf{T}$ and the $\mathbf{P B}$ using an 8 mm ring. String 2 x T of the same length and the vertical eye of the PB. Connect $6 \mathrm{x}_{4} \mathrm{~T}_{4}$, 6x T5 and 6x T6.


Step 7:
Connect the created pendants to the chain using the 5 mm rings. Snip off any unnecessary length of the chain (the example uses 54 cm ). Find the central link. Hang a T6 pendant from it.
Hang another pendant from every fifth link. Hang the $\mathbf{T}_{5}, \mathbf{T}_{4}, \mathbf{T}_{6}, \mathbf{T}_{5}, \mathbf{T}_{4}, \mathbf{T}_{6}, \mathrm{~T}_{5}$ and $\mathbf{T}_{4}$ in a mirrored sequence on both sides.


Step 8:
Attach the carabiner and counterpart to the end links.
